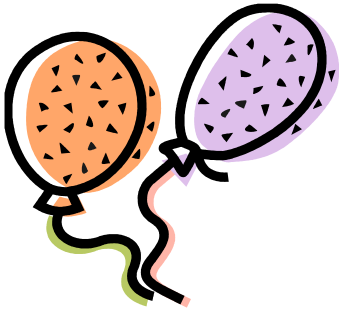

*Prices valid ONLY on Fair Days, other days are subject to regular fees

*Prices include vaccine, HC (one species per HC), stop charge, and hourly rate

You **must** call in ahead of these days to reserve a slot. There are a limited number of slots on each fair day that will be filled on a first come basis.

Please call ASAP to make sure to get the day you want. We will not take any new calls after 5pm the night prior to the Fair Day. Please give a phone number where you can be reached on Fair Day and the address of the animals.

Animals need to be tied up and identified and all paperwork in order. Animals or paperwork not organized will be subject to regular fees.

Please do not call on the actual fair day to see when we will be there; we will call throughout the day with an estimate of our arrival time.

REQUIREMENTS FOR 2014 FAIR

All cattle and pigs **MUST** have USDA approved official ear tags:

Metal tags that begin with 21 or NY (ex. 21ABC1234 or 21HOG tags)

15 digit tags starting with 840, UDA, 9 (ex. 840 123 456 789 012)

Tattoos are **NO LONGER** acceptable permanent ID.

Sheep and goats are required to have a scrapie tag

Papers **WILL NOT** be issued unless payment is received at the time of service.

The certificate is valid for all additional fairs during the 2014 fair season in NYS.

Please remember to be flexible as we are doing this to help the 4-H members.
