#### The "How-To's" for checking on Newborn Immunity from Colostrum.

Go to *atticacows.com*. From the "Resources" dropdown menu select the top item, "Calf Facts Resource Menu." Scroll down to "Testing for Transfer of Immunity." The ten-point summary at the beginning will allow you to quickly pick out the information that you need. We have all the necessary

supplies available at the vet clinic.

#### **BioPRYN Reminders**

BioPRYN® is a blood pregnancy test for ruminants (cattle, sheep, goats). **How soon post-breeding can animals be tested?** Heifers can be tested 25 days post breeding and cows can be tested at 28 days or later, after breeding. Lactating cows must also be 73 days after calving.

**How much does BioPRYN cost?** The test itself costs \$2.50 for cattle and \$6.75 for sheep and goats at our laboratory, plus the cost of a sample tube and needle. Shipping expenses also must be added if the tests are not delivered to our Attica lab.

**How should blood samples be prepared and shipped?** Farm personnel need to draw blood samples from the tail or jugular vein, which is an easily learnt procedure. Blood samples of at least 2 mL per animal should be collected in individual vacuum tubes.

# **Preventing Pneumonia in Young Dairy Calves**

When feeding colostrum, match the feeding rate to the swallowing rate – do not give in to the temptation to cut out the end of the nursing bottle nipple to "hurry things along." [Spanish: ¡Espera! ¡No se corta esa chupón!] Saving a few minutes at colostrum feeding often costs us time and drug costs to treat pneumonia later.

- Use a tube feeder properly. No fluid in the tube while it is either going into the throat (esophagus) or on the way out.
