DIPPING NAVELS

- 1. Put on a clean pair of nitrile gloves.
- 2. Use fresh clean navel dip for each calf.

Always throw away soiled dip; start with fresh, clean dip before every calf.

Navel dip is brown, stains your fingers and has an alcohol smell. If navel dip is not available isopropanol alcohol is better to use than teat dip.

3. Using navel dip, wash the umbilical cord and navel opening until they are clean.

Wash off all the manure and dirt from the entire cord and navel opening.

- 4. With the brown dip, cover the entire cord all the way to the belly as well as the navel opening.
- 5. Redip the cord and navel opening after the calf is removed from the dam.
