Chill Colostrum Before Refrigerating

Research has shown that household refrigerators are ineffective for rapid chilling of colostrum. It is no surprise that large quantities of colostrum (e.g. 5 gallons) take a long time to chill. When put into a refrigerator right after collection, five gallons of 90°F colostrum take ~24 hours to cool down to 40°F. Even a single gallon of colostrum in two nursing bottles took over 10 hours to cool down to 40°F. Both of these cooling rates leave plenty of time for coliform bacteria to multiply, yielding severely contaminated colostrum. Here are some strategies to rapidly chill colostrum to 60°F before it goes into the refrigerator:

- 1. After bottling the colostrum, sit the bottle into an ice water bath for 30 min. Cap the bottles and refrigerate immediately afterwards.
- Keep clean bottles filled with ice in a freezer. Place bottles of ice into a pail of warm colostrum for 30 minutes – the ice to colostrum ratio is 1 part ice:4 parts colostrum. Cover the pail and place in refrigerator.
