## **EXCEDE**

<u>Indications</u>: Treatment of Respiratory disease in lactating cows.

<u>Dosage</u>: 1.5cc/100lbs given behind the ear (in fat pad) subcutaneously only



Route of Administration: Behind ear at base – in the fat pad – subcutaneously only If given anywhere else, meat withhold has not been established. (Contact your vet immediately)

Withholding: Milk: 0 hours

Meat: 13 days

Contraindications: Injection into arteries of an animal's ear is likely to result in sudden death. Penicillins and cephalosporins can cause allergic reactions in sensitized individuals.

**Storage Conditions**: Room temperature
