

DIPPING NAVELS

1. Use fresh clean navel dip

- **Always dump out soiled dip; start with fresh dip before every calf.**
- **Navel dip is brown and has an alcohol smell.**

2. Wash off “MUD” with dip

- **“MUD” is manure, urine and dirt.**
- **Use enough dip to get a clean umbilical cord and navel opening at belly.**

3. Dip the full length of the cord in clean navel dip. Coat navel opening in belly with dip.

4. Redip after the calf is removed from the dam.
